Vaccinations

All pets **MUST** be up to date on vaccinations prior to boarding. Proof of vaccination must be on file at the time of boarding, or they will be administered upon admission at the expense of the owner. Required vaccinations for dogs include Rabies, Distemper and Bordetella. Required vaccinations for cats include Rabies and Distemper.

Fecal Testing

Roseville Veterinary Clinic requires fecal exams every six (6) months due to the zoonotic risk of intestinal parasites. If this has not been performed in the last six (6) months, a fecal sample will be tested here at an additional fee.

Flea Prevention

Roseville Veterinary Clinic is a flea free facility. In order to maintain this standard, flea treatment is required for boarding. The **ONLY** products that we will accept are Vectra 3D, Advantix, Advantage/Multi, Frontline Gold, Revolution, Siparica, Bravecto, Nexgard or Seresto.

If your pet has not been treated with a flea product within the labeled use period, or there is evidence of fleas, we will provide a flea treatment at the expense of the owner.



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Personal Items

Please do not bring bedding with your boarding pets. We will provide plenty of comfortable bedding for them, provided that they do not chew it. You are welcome to bring toys, or other personal items that you would like while boarding. Due to the higher stress nature of boarding, your pet may be more likely to chew or destroy toys and other personal items. Roseville Veterinary Clinic is not responsible for personal items left with pets. Please remove all leashes, collars, harnesses, and clothing before dropping your pet off for boarding. Due to a choking risk, these will not be left on boarding animals.

Medical Services

If you wish to have any medical services performed while your pet is here boarding, inform the receptionist at check-in. Medical services will be performed and charged at the customary rates while the pet is in the hospital.
